- British or a citizen of the Commonwealth. Please check on the gov.uk website for advice about EU citizens candidacy rights in local elections.
- At least 18 years old.
- Registered to vote in the area or have lived, worked, or owned property there for at least twelve months before an election.

You can't be a Councillor if you:

- Are the subject of bankruptcy restrictions order or interim order.
- Have been sentenced to prison for three months or more (including suspended sentences) in the previous five years before this co-option.
- Have been convicted of a corrupt or illegal practice by an election court.
- Are subject to any relevant notification requirements, or a relevant order, in respect of a sexual offence.
